VINEYARD CHARACTER

Ghielmetti Vineyard comprises 64 acres and 11 different varieties. On the lower half, in fine-grained loamy soil, we harvest Cabernet Franc from a 3-acre block of ENTAV clone 332. Adjacent to the hillsides separating Livermore from the Central Valley, this site is one of the coolest in the appellation, ripening about a week later than Sachau Vineyard.

TASTING NOTES

This wine is redder and nimbler than the wine from Sachau, showing more forward fruit and a more obvious acid-driven edge. Harkening to the wines from the Loire Valley with their purity of fruit, this wine, shows characteristic notes of sage and bay and substantial mid-palate roundness and tannin on the finish. Drink over the next 10-15 years.
